The Lost Art of Travelers is a dynamic group exhibition by the current participants from Le Pavillon, an international post-graduate artist residency program at the Palais de Tokyo in Paris, which this year includes 9 artists and 1 curator. This exhibition at Dallas Contemporary begins an annual series of collaborations with international residency programs that create opportunities for world exhibition experience for artists and encourage focused art works or curatorial themes involving Dallas or Texas.

The exhibition features artists Jérôme Allavena, Einat Amir, Elisabeth E. Clark, Gintaras Didziarapetris, Alexandra Ferreira, Morten Norbye Halvorsen, Fabrice Pichat, Charlotte Seidel, and Bettina Wind from Le Pavillon; also participating are guest artists Florence Lazar and Christian Merlhiot, who is currently serving as the education director at Le Pavillon. Estelle Nabeyrat will curate the exhibition.
